# **Happy Hub Extension**

SODC have granted planning permission to the Parish Council to build an extension to The Pavilion on Station Road.

The extension will provide a purpose-built home for the Happy Hub, Cholsey's own children and family centre.

The new building will give the Happy Hub a large activity room, separate small interview/meeting room, and a kitchenette.

Happy Hub team leader, Sarah Wilson, said "we are delighted with the plans as the new room will give us more space and the opportunity to do more activities"

The Parish Council will also benefit from a new exterior store for the maintenance person and a new office space.
