CHOLSEY PARISH COUNCIL

Minutes of the meeting duly convened and held on Wednesday 19th May 2021 at 7.30pm via Zoom

Present were Cllrs Worley(Chair), Smith, Seed, Bamford, Pomlett, Dyer-Lynch, Bolt, Neill and Riley.

Also present the Clerk, County Councillor Bloomfield and one member of the public

Cllr Worley reminded members that the meeting is an advisory meeting for the Clerk under delegated powers.

23. To receive apologies for absence

Apologies were received from Cllrs Herbert, Hope-Smith, Jenkins and District Cllr Simpson.

24. To hear questions or comments from members of the public (max 15 mins) The Pavilion Trust treasurer spoke about the air source heat pumps in the Pavilion and the report that the pumps need a complete review and replacement. It will cost £65,000 to complete the works. There are some grants available and claiming against the builder. Trust has had grants and insurance claim for the loss of income. The Happy Hub needs urgent transfer to Trust.

25. To receive any reports from County and/or District Councillors

County Cllr Bloomfield introduced himself to Council. OCC had their first full meeting of the new council yesterday. It's frustrating not to be able to meet the officers in person. Covid cases are low but residents need to act with caution. Cllr Bloomfield happy to help where he can.

26. To receive Declarations of Personal and Pecuniary Interest for any agenda items

Cllrs Bolt and Dyer-Lynch declared a personal interest in the Pavilion as Trustees.

29. To note Clerk's Report

The contractor has still not carried out the tree works in the recreation field. The Estate Manager has obtained an alternative quote from the grass cutting contractors which is slightly more expensive. However the matter is now urgent and it was agreed to go ahead with the new quote.

30. To discuss burial ground maintenance

Cllr Seed reported that if the rabbits are to be kept out of the graveyard then gates need to be installed not just a fence. Benches also need attention.

31. To agree regular monitoring of defibrillators

Cllrs Worley, Park and Neill agreed to monitor the defibrillators. Clerk to organise.

32. To agree new signage for the recreation ground

Cllr Seed has put signs up about dog mess. Link on how to report dog mess

36. To discuss replacement of Pavilion Air Source Heat Pumps

Cllr Bolt reported on the issues with the air source heat pumps in the pavilion. The design is inefficient and obsolete. The matter was discussed and Cllr Worley summarised the problem. It was agreed that the builder needs to take some responsibility for the costs. The work has got to be done. Cllr Worley proposed that Council write to the builder and insist on a meeting. Legal advice should also be sought. Cllr Worley to lead. The Parish Council accepts its responsibility to make the pumps work. Need to urgently put the work out to tender.
